8-9 A.M: Citrus Expo registration and Fruit Contest Registration. Horry/Georgetown Conference Center. Fruit registration forms will be available at the Expo site. If entering fruit for judging, Be sure that you have at least 3 fruit from every cultivar that you plan to enter. We request that at least one of the fruits have a stem and leaf attached. Fruits will be displayed on round plates (provided) with each display having two whole fruits and one sliced in half. Categories for fruit are as follows: Sweet oranges, Mandarins, Grapefruits & Pummelos, Limes, Lemons, Kumquats, Complex Hybrids (thomasvilles , citranges, etc.) Sour Oranges. Fruit must be entered by 9 am. No entries accepted after this time. All fruit entries are to be taken to room 601 for judging.

Directions to McKenzie Farms for Fridays-on-the-way-tour: Stan's grove is just a short distance from I-95 and will be open for visitors from 9-3 pm on Friday the 16th.

From the North on I-95 take exit 150 (Sardis Exit) This is aprox. 11 miles south of Florence, SC. Exit off and take a left at the top of the ramp going back across the interstate. You will be on Hwy 403. Follow 403 for about 5 miles until it intersects with Hwy 341. Follow 341 to the town of Olanta, SC (watch speed here!) Go straight across at the stop sign and continue 5 miles on 341. Stan's place will be on the left.

From the South, take Exit 135 (Turbeville, SC exit) Take right turn at the top of the ramp and drive aprox 5 miles into the town of Turbeville, Take left at stop light and follow 378/301 to the IGA food store. Turn left in front of IGA on hwy 301.. go 6 miles north to Olanta and then turn right on Hwy 341. Stan's place is 5 miles out on the left. If coming from the west on I-20. Take the Bishopville/Lynchburg exit.. This is Hwy 341. Follow 341 thru the towns of Lynchburg and Olanta and Stan's place is 5 miles out of Olanta on the left.
